In this connection during year 2016, SFAC has undertaken procurement of Moong under MSP using FPOs as procurement agencies in 5 States, namely Telangana, Karnataka, Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh and Rajasthan with a total procurement of 26226.87 MT. Awareness camps/publicity/Activities sessions in all 66 mandis of UP including Mathura, Agra, Aligarh districts have been conducted under NAM.
2	How many commodity and no. of farmers doing bidding on national agricultural market scheme, funds used and benefits taken by farmers.	Total 10,15,206 farmers have participated in bidding on e-NAM portal as on 05.01.2017. Total 69 commodities have been notified for trading on e-NAM. Funds released under e-NAM scheme does not go to the farmers directly. Benefits accrued therefrom (the funds) are indirectly incidental to various services offered to the farmer on the e-NAM platform.
