S. No	Question	Reply
1	Till June, 2017, how many new states are enrolled in the e-NAM platform and how many new e-mandis are connected with the portal. And also please tell that how many states are going to join in near future?	There are 13 State enrolled in e-NAM platform. So far 455 mandis are connected with e-NAM.
2	Till June, 2017 how many farmers of 8 different states were benefited through e-NAM portal with brief details of their transaction of different commodities and how much they earn through the portal.?	Till 30 June, 2017, in 13 States, there were 4790821 farmers have been benefitted transacting on e-NAM portal with different commodities with a total trade value of Rs. 23131.06 Crores.
3	Why the States like Bihar, Odisha, Chattisgarh are not joined to the e-NAM platform yet though most of their population depend on agriculture?	Odisha & Chhattisgarh States have joined e-NAM. So far, we have not received the proposal of Government of Bihar.
