Government has launched a website: enam.gov.in for farmers to sell their produce through online bidding without involvement of any mediator and has a transparent price discovery mechanism.
2	I heard about online update status about crops price and dealing directly with buyers without intervention of mediators and black marketing,	Farmers can directly sell their produce to purchasers through online bidding process. There is no reason of black marketing as the e-NAM process is completely transparent and quick as the entire process is computerised.
3	If so methods are there how affective is it going on in my village brahmanakodur, Ponnur mandal, Guntur district, Andhra Pradesh.	Your village is under Guntur mandi wherein trade of 340453 MT for Rs. 2826 Cr took place from 14 th April 2016 to 11 th May, 2018 through e-NAM and farmers registered in Guntur mandi as 222683.
