



**Proposal to empanel technical partners to design and operate ICT supported MIS
for monitoring
Programme for Integrated Production of Pulses in Rainfed Areas &
National Vegetable Initiative in Urban Clusters
in
Small Farmers' Agribusiness Consortium**

Eligibility and bidding process

The following are eligible to apply for empanelment to support this project:

1. Any public sector or private sector institution
2. Any Trust, Society, Cooperative, partnership firm or other body registered under an existing Statute.

Provided that:

1. The institution has completed at least 3 years of functioning (financial years) as on 1st April 2011.
2. Audited financial reports of the last 2 years available (i.e. upto financial year ending 31st March 2010) and provided that the annual turnover of the institution in the last year is not less than Rs. 2.00 crore.
3. The institution has direct experience of providing agriculture project related technical services in India, in particular in the area of ICT supported MIS. *Proof of designing and running such a system will have to be provided through live demonstration.*
4. It has on its rolls experienced staff/consultants with direct experience of designing and operating such systems.
5. The institution is not black-listed by any Central or State agency.
6. It is in compliance of all necessary laws and statutes on the date of application.

Bid methodology

In the first stage only technical empanelment will be undertaken. Applicants should submit a detailed profile covering all the points listed above, together with copies of

documents to support their claims. Once the technical qualifications have been checked, short listed bidders will be invited to submit detailed proposals including financial bids. A pre-bid conference will be held with short listed bidders to provide details of the project requirements before detailed proposals are invited.
