

SFAC has taken up eNAM activities to sustain the farmers/FPOs/traders business during the COVID-19 lockdown period in the country:

To enhance the effectiveness and strengthen the agriculture produce supply chain by the Farmers/Farmer Producer Organizations (FPOs)/traders in the country and to reduce their need to physically come to mandis. The following three (3) features are taken up in eNAM:

- i. FPO trading module: FPO trading module whereby FPOs can trade their produce from their collection center without bringing the produce to APMC.
- ii. Logistic module: In addition to facilitate inter-mandi and inter-state trade at this juncture, enhanced version of logistic module whereby aggregators of transport logistic platform have on boarded which helps users to avail trackable transport facilities for transporting their produce.
- iii. eNWR module: 'Negotiable Warehouse Receipt' (e-NWRs) based trading module to facilitate the trade from warehouses itself based on e-NWR.

Status of eNAM business under SFAC are:

- **e-NAM Business** - From March 25, 2020 to 17th April, 2020, a volume of 73,030.14 MT worth Rs 153.55 Cr got traded on e-NAM. Total 268 mandis out of 585 were operative
- During the period of 25th March 2020 to 17th April 2020, Out of the 74,925 lots arrived, total 44,094 lots got traded. About 50% of the traded lots (19,562) got assayed for quality.
- Amongst the traded volume of 73,030.14 MT, 40% belonged to fruit and vegetable, 44% cereals and 8% pulses crops. The rest were oilseeds, fiber and spices.
- As per the value traded of Rs 153.55 Cr, 38% belonged to cereals, 24% fruit and vegetable, 15% pulses and 7% fiber. Rest were oilseeds, spices and forest produce.
- During this period, due to restricted movement in many States, farmers' registration was 3121, mainly from the States of Jharkhand, Maharashtra, Puducherry, Madhya Pradesh and West Bengal. Also, 76 traders & 21 Commission agents were registered during this period
- **Farmer Producer Organisation** – Till April 17th 2020, Total 36 Different FPOs from 11 states (Odisha, Gujarat, Rajasthan, West Bengal, Maharashtra, Haryana, Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh and Jharkhand) have traded 1753 quintals of commodities and 2710 number of coconut worth Rs. 41,50,791.

- **Helpdesk Calls & Mobile App** – Total 733 farmers, 60 FPOs, 3 Govt. officials, 41 traders, etc. have called on eNAM Call Centre totalling to 891 Calls during this lockdown period.
- Category wise 362 calls for enquiry, 302 for registration, 194 calls for information purpose & others were attended by the eNAM helpdesk team during the lock down period.
- **Website Visitors & eNAM Android App**– Total 2571 visitors visited on eNAM Logistics page & out of them 613 visitors visited Truck Suvidha, 122 Rivigo, 61 Transin, 82 Truck Guru, 34 Elastic Run, 34 Mavyn & 43 Blackbuck from the eNAM logistics page during 1st to 17th April'2020
- 7276 users have downloaded eNAM mobile app on their android phones during 1st to 17th April 2020.
- Total number of 27,630 bids were submitted via android mobile app during 1st to 17th April 2020
- Logistics Aggregators Linked – 9 Logistics Aggregators partnered with eNAM having 2,31,300 transporters linked with them, taking total trucks count to 11,37,700 during 1st April to 17th April 2020.
