b)	the total value of agricultural produce traded through the e-NAM platform since its inception;	Till 28th Feb 2025, a total of 11.30 crore MT of various agricultural commodities and 44.95 crore Nos. of commodities like Coconut, Betel leaf, Sweet Corn, Lemon and Bamboo (which are traded in numbers) were traded. Total trade value of Rs. 4,12,436 crores have been recorded on e-NAM portal.	
c)	the future plans to expand the e- NAM platform, including the target number of mandis to be integrated and the strategies being adopted to increase farmer participation?	At present, 1473 APMC are integrated with e-NAM portal. As per the current e-NAM guidelines, states themselves identify mandis to be integrated with e- NAM and send DPR proposals for mandi integration to the ministry. Therefore, states can get more APMC yards onboarded on the e-NAM portal. One time grant of Rs. 30 Lakhs is being provided to the States / UTs for each mandi integrated with e- NAM for purchase of hardware, internet connection, assaying equipment and related infrastructure. Additionally, Rs. 40 lakhs per mandi is also provided for the purchase of cleaning, grading and packaging

and related infrastructure/facilities.

Two training programs are being conducted annually for all e-NAM Mandis for the farmers & other stakeholders to promote the farmers' access to the online marketplace. Till 28.02.2025 13,30,696 farmers/FPOs across India have been trained. e-NAM applications is available through web & mobile applications. Tutorial videos are available on social media platforms as well.

In order to strengthen and technologically upgrade-NAM, redevelopment of e-NAM is underway wherein provision is there for integrating microservices, assaying services, logistics, payment services etc.
