

Till 28.02.2025 13,30,696 farmers/FPOs across India have been trained. e-NAM applications is available through web & mobile applications. Tutorial videos are available on social media platforms as well.
b)	steps taken to promote inter-state trade through e-NAM, the details thereof?	e-NAM is reviewed continuously by the department to support the farmers for trade. A toll-free helpline is set up under eNAM for resolving problems faced by eNAM users including farmers. To promote the interstate trades, trade allied service providers such as logistic services providers, warehousing services providers and others are onboarded on the platform of platforms module of the e-NAM.
